What is a drop off analysis?

A drop off analysis is a directed implementation strategy to determine where a program loses participants



The Process

- Collect Data
- Discuss the Results
- Decide On and Implement Improvements
- Repeat

How are drop-off analyses useful?

- Ongoing data monitoring walk-through your system
- Strategic data collection helps courts choose change management strategies that are the most effective
- It can help answer the "why" questions about disparities
 - Should include other indicators
 - "Number and percentage completing treatment by race/ethnicity"
